City of Tioga Special Election: December 10th

The City of Tioga has set a date of December 10, 2024 to hold a Special Election for the open City Commission seat. The election will be held at Tioga City Hall from 10AM to 7PM. This position will serve as the City of Tioga Street Commissioner.

One candidate has been identified that will be on the ballot to fill the open position..Kyle Ralston. Kyle shared the following information about himself and would ask for your vote on December 10th. Kyle is originally from Petersburg ND, a small town of 150 people. In November of 2013, Kyle moved to Tioga and pursued employment in the Oil Patch. His hobbies include volunteering at the Tioga Fire and Ambulance Department, being active on other boards in Tioga and he enjoys assisting with agriculture in the field during seeding and harvest as well as travelling the United States on his Harley Davidson Motorcycle.



• Why did you decide to run for a commission seat?

I would like to serve as a City Commissioner because Tioga is my new hometown. I am very involved in the Community and I have an interest in the success of my community as a homeowner and taxpayer.

- What is something you would like to accomplish if elected to serve as a Commissioner for the City of Tioga? I would like to see more progress on infrastructure improvements throughout the city.

<u>Pinnacle Agronomy Expands into new facilities! - Jim Wznick, CEO & Chris Husted, Location Manager</u> Tioga Pinnacle Agronomy department will be relocating soon to its new facilities south of town on Highway 40.

C.E.O. Jim Wznick and Agronomy location Manager Chris Husted stated that "we have outgrown our current facilities and there was a dire need to improve our speed of delivery while also having the capability to store more product on hand to capture better pricing at different times of the year.

The Project began with the purchase of the former Shopko building on Highway 40 south of Tioga. The 36000 square foot building will be used to store and retail crop protection, seed, feed and lubricants products which also includes the storage of Bulk DEF. Most of the renovations have been completed except for the offices which will be located in the southeast corner of the building that will be completed sometime in January. Future plans are being worked out to offer a full line of sprayer parts, hoses, Banjo fittings, transfer pumps and all necessary fittings and parts for transferring liquid and dry agricultural products. In addition to acquiring the former Shopko building, Pinnacle purchased 10 acres of land to the West and South of the building. Construction began in April of a 7500-ton Dry Fertilizer storage facility for agricultural purposes and will be completed in January and ready to begin receiving product. Chris Husted added that "the loadout equipment of this facility will greatly improve the speed of delivery to our customers."

In addition to the new facilities, new equipment has been added which includes an additional dry fertilizer spreader, new payloader for loading the dry fertilizer, new forklift with plans to add an additional sprayer for custom applications.

There have also been additions to the staff of our agronomy department. "We have a very good group of employees working for us" stated Wznick and Husted, and we are committed to employing more employees which will include a full-time agronomist along with 2 more equipment operators.

Wznick concluded by stating that "Pinnacle's board and management is committed to offering products and services for our core business of serving our owners which are the Farmers and Ranchers of our community".


