TIOGA AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES 2024 GRANTS

The Tioga Area Community Foundation (TACF) Advisory Committee awarded \$6,900 in grants to local nonprofits in 2024 as follows:

- Junior Achievement North: \$400 Tioga Classroom Programming 2024-25
- Tioga Historical Society Inc: \$6,500 Expansion of Norseman Museum

The funding for these grants came from the TACF Endowment Fund; a permanent savings account that grows over time, providing charitable income for projects and programs forever.

Many projects happening at the Tioga Municipal Airport - Jeffery Moe Jr.

As we started a new year with many projects ahead for 2024, we reorganized the Tioga Airport Authority Board with a new member. Jeffery Moe was named as new Chairman of the board and airport manager, Paul Weyrauch retained his seat as Vice President, our new member David Pegal was named Secretary/Treasurer. Other members of the board are Dean Hanson and Curtis Vande Sandt. Our ever-busy bookkeeper Patrica Hove is a blessing to say the least.

We hit the ground running in the spring. We started construction on our new 6-plex tee hanger project the airport had purchased back in 2022. which will help pilots already on the field and bring them from abroad to Tioga Airport. Then we set our sights on our existing terminal. Built in 2018, a few cosmetics were introduced. Decals on the doors, brushed aluminum letters on the outside naming the terminal "Tioga Municipal Airport " along with moving a few locks around for safety reasons. Next came our federal project starting in May. New Taxiway lights with a new Vault building for all our electrical needs for the lights. Which will help pilots navigate from the runway to either terminal or hangers. Then we decided to add FAA weather cameras to our beacon, to assist anyone curious about the weather just outside of town. And if flying is a dream of yours, then reach out! TAA and Minot Aero Center have an agreement to send an instructor and airplane to teach you to fly, it is just a phone call away!

We also had our fly in during the freedom fest/all school reunion. The Tioga airport Authority was beyond happy with the turnout that we had between 500 and 700 people show up we ran out of food unfortunately, but we were glad we could make some memories for people. Thanks again to everybody that showed up.

This is just a brief rundown of what has happened in just over half a year, we have many ambitious projects in the future, and we invite all that would like to be a part of it, or just sit in and learn what is going on at our amazing airport. "Airports are economical engines" a quote from Kyle Wanner our North Dakota Aeronautics Commission President said in a recent interview, and I could not agree with him more. There are many new and exciting things coming to Tioga, and I hope to see you all at our monthly meetings held the 3rd Thursday of every month at 7:00pm at the Tioga Airport Terminal. Thank you!
